

Wilkes Youth Life Development (WYLD) is a youth serving non-profit organization focused on developing healthy and resilient youth in Wilkes County. Our goal is to give them the support and skills they may need to become successful, independent adults. We plan to accomplish our mission by modeling healthy relationships, building positive environments, providing meaningful experiences, and creating a sustainable organization through strong governance and community partnerships. We serve Wilkes County youth ages 8-18. We strive to serve youth regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, or socioeconomic status.

This year, one of our big achievements was hosting a focus group. We wanted to hear thoughts from youth in Wilkes County on mental health, substance misuse and youth programing in the county. We learned what exactly the youth in our county feel that they need to be successful. Now, as we move forward we can meet their needs with our programs.

TEEN ACTION COUNCIL

The purpose of the Teen Advisory Council (TAC) is to empower youth within Wilkes County to pursue positive, healthy, and substance-free choices through evidence-based advocacy and skill building programs, social support, and positive youth development activities. TAC is youth-led and adult-quided to ensure that program recipients, Wilkes County youth, are engaged in the planning and implementation of activities. The adult "leaders" will focus on facilitating accessible and open community collaboration between stakeholders in order to create a well-trained team and optimize the amount of youth being served through TAC. TAC will also focus on engaging youth and families in evidence-based activities to increase the knowledge and preparation of the target population to make healthy choices. TAC began with 5 members and has grown to 12 kids in the past six months. This group of teens is dedicated and passionate about bringing change to Wilkes.

WHAT'S NEXT...

- Implement a teen Mental Health First Aid curriculum for 10th-12th grade students within all five of our public high schools, reaching around 1.905 students
- Expand our Teen Action Council into each of our high schools using the Positive Action model, expecting 7-12 kids in each school club.
- Create a middle school version of our Teen Action Council that will be lead by our TAC leaders.
- Start a Youth Connection Podcast that will connect youth from all across the county and highlight what is going on in the lives of Wilkes County youth.
